
There are two types of course revisions.

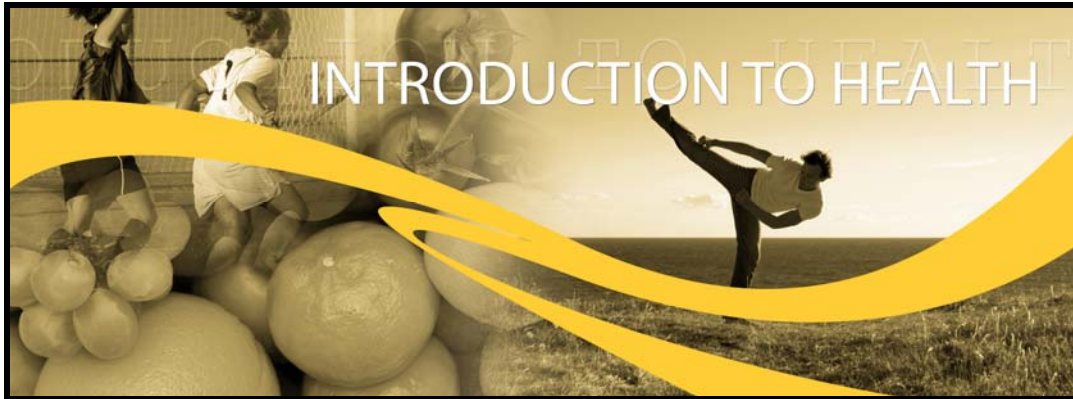
